

Fee Structure of B. Ed. 2011-12

- * College Fee: (Interim- as decided by the State) ` 51,250
- * Proposed Final College Fee: as per the recommendation of State appointed CA (Subject to final decision of Fee Fixation Committee of State)
- * University Examination Fee- (As per CCS University Rules) Extra
- * Refundable Security - Library ` 2,000
- Science and Computer Lab ` 4,000

Anomalies In Interim Fee fixed by the Government (by the G.O. dated 07/04/2011)


1. Post of the Principal of the College has not been taken into account;
2. 2- part time assistant professors i.e. one for Arts and Craft and another for Sports and Yoga, who are required as per NCTE norms are not taken into the account;
3. Although NCTE has not specifically any guideline regarding number of Class III and class IV employees to be appointed by the recognized colleges / institutions imparting B Ed course, however, in view of the proper and smooth functioning as well as the proper upkeep of the infrastructural facilities of the college as per Standards and Norms fixed by NCTE, the number of class III and class IV employees considered by the State is not realistic.
4. Only 3-Class III employees are allowed; whereas the minimum practically required number of Class III employees is 12 as mentioned below-
 - a. Accountant- 1
 - b. Registrar / Office Superintendent- 1
 - c. Librarian/ Cataloguer - 1
 - d. Computer Lab Technician - 1
 - e. Lab Assistants -3 (For five compulsory labs)
 - f. Receptionist -1.
 - g. Computer Operator cum Typist -1
 - h. Library Assistant (Issue and Receipt Clerk) -1
 - i. PA to Principal- 1
 - j. Liaison Officer cum Supervisor- 1

5. Only 3- Class IV employees are allowed; whereas keeping in view the minimum required land area for a college as per State Rules especially in areas other than Cities of Municipal Corporation and of Municipal Boards, is 20,000 sq metre and for running the B. Ed. Course in the College minimum covered area as per NCTE norms and standards is 15,000 Sq ft.. The minimum number of Class IV employees thus required is 16 as mentioned below-
- Peons- 3
 - Sweepers- 2
 - Gardeners / Mali- 3
 - Guards / Gate Keepers / Gunmen/ Night Watchmen- 4
 - Library Book Lifter- 1
 - Electrician / Plumber/Driver- 2
 - Cycle / Scooter Stand-Keeper- 1
6. In view of increasing costs of support services, printing & stationery, electricity supply or electricity generating costs (Diesel etc.), the decade old formula of allocating 20% to 25% of the total cost for co-curricular and extra-curricular activities of operating B.Ed. course as per the State G.O. of dating back i.e. year 2000 or 2002 is not practical at all. This cost is now not less than 40% - 45% of the total operating cost and this is also the recorded facts as per the audited statements of accounts of the colleges of the past two years. Such records now are available very much with the Government.
7. Further it is stated the CCS University running Self-finance Courses in the Campus is segregating 40% of the fee for the purpose of Other Recurring Expenses; whereas, it's entire infrastructure costs are met by the exchequer.
8. The interim assessment of the fee by the committee did not considered the cost of academic tour which is a part of the curriculum of B. Ed. prescribed by the NCTE and affiliating, CCS University, Meerut.
9. The cost of Internal Examination, Monthly Class Tests, Micro-Teaching Practice, University Examination and Practical Examination has not been taken into account.
10. The prescribed margin for development of the institution which may be ranging from 6% - 15 % as opined by Hon'ble Justice Sinha in Islamic Academy case in Supreme Court has not taken into account by the fee fixation committee of the State.

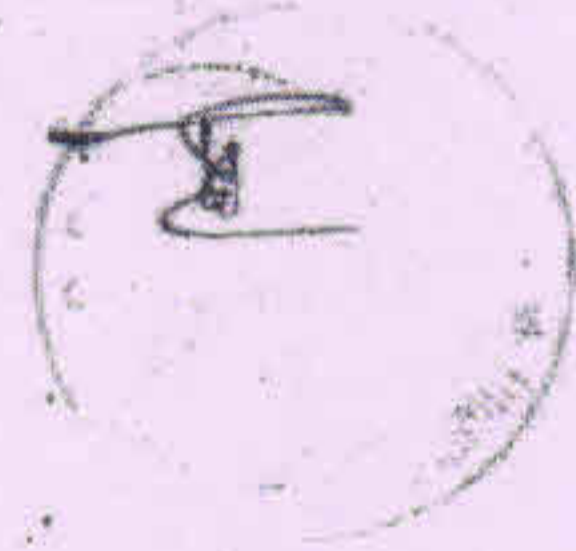
Para- 156 of Islamic Academy Judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court reads as- "While this court has not laid down any fixed guidelines as regards fee structure, in my opinion, reasonable



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surplus should ordinarily vary from 6% to 15%, as such surplus would be utilized for expansion of the system and development of education.")

Hence, in no case the interim fee of ₹ 51,250 as decided by the committee is realistic and is also an indirect interference in the right of the private unaided colleges to administer the institutions. Therefore, final fixation of fee must take into consideration the above narrated anomalies and facts.




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
